

# Finding Procurement Opportunities?

Before looking for procurement opportunities it is important to know your organisation.

#### Key features:

- What are your strengths and weakness? (SWOT analysis)
- Where do you want to deliver and where are you currently able to deliver?
- What is your current capacity?
- Does your organisation have a long-term plan?

#### Research

- Is there a market for your service/product?
- How competitive is the market?
- Is the organisation ready to tender?

#### Who?

- Local authorities (Dumfries and Galloway Council)
- The National Health Service (<u>NHS Dumfries and Galloway</u>)
- The Scottish Government and other government agencies (Scottish Enterprise)
- Key public services such as police, fire service & judiciary
- Further and Higher Educations (<u>Colleges & Universities</u>)
- Non-departmental government bodies (Historic Environmental Scotland)
- UK government departments based in Scotland (Inland Revenue, Jobcentre Plus)

### Sources of public sector tender opportunities

- Public Contracts Scotland (PCS) Alerts, Quick Quotes, Searches
- Buyer websites
- Annual procurement reports
- Supplier Events
